

MINUTES OF THE BALRANALD SHIRE EUSTON BEAUTIFICATION & TOURISM MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE MEETING HELD AT THE MULTI-PURPOSE BUILDING, EUSTON ON TUESDAY 6th MAY 2014 COMMENCING AT 9.10AM

PRESENT: Cr Ken Barnes (Chair), Cr Leigh Byron, Mr Barry Watts, Mrs Maureen Pupillo, Mrs Bev Harbinson and John Stevenson DID.

APOLOGIES: Mrs Vicki Barnes and Mrs Edna Price.

Previous minutes were tabled and confirmed.

Business:

1. Historical Society wishes to thank Council for the replacement of a refrigerator in the Euston Courthouse tea rooms.
2. Cr Byron requested a press release in relation to the commencement of works to construct the third approach bridge to the Euston Robinvale crossing. DID to action.
3. Discussion on progress towards the Courthouse external improvements. DID to liaise with builder for exterior roof repairs and painting, and investigate the practicalities of removing paint from external brickwork.
4. A discussion took place regarding Medley Park stage 2 works. Committee to further address this work via a concept plan. The plan to form part of the overall Euston plan.
5. Council to liaise with the adjacent landowners at Berrett Park, in relation to the improvement concept for this area, following their interest in “adopting” some of the maintenance aspects.
6. MOVED by consensus, “Council adopt a policy to restrict monuments in the Euston lawn cemetery to a maximum height of 500mm” – Carried
7. DID to provide permanent marking numbers to each lawn cemetery plot to simplify the reservation process.

General Discussion:

The DID to attend to the following items:

- Liaise with Mens Shed regarding wave seats, Courthouse door refurbishment and headstone refurbishment.

- Remove plaques from Cenotaph Park and either refurbish or replace.
- Advise RMS of signage damage at roundabout.
- Erect “No Truck Parking” signage to Pickerings frontage.
- Liaise with builder on Murray Terrace toilet internal refurbishment (external screen and signage to form part of above town concept plan).
- Cemetery entrance plantings to be provided as per Main Street shrubs.
- Council to provide a media release on petition handover to Minister Humphries regarding Lake Benanee.
- Maintenance to Lake Benanee road and weed spraying required.
- DID to approach semi-permanent campers on Lake Benanee beach area.
- DID to recommence regular dog patrolling.
- Council to consider the replacement of Murray Terrace footpath pavers between the Courthouse and the Hotel as a priority.

There being no further business the meeting closed at 10.30am.
