FUNDING ANNOUNCED - 2018 COMMUNITY BUILDING PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM

The electorate of Murray has today secured nearly \$330,000 in funding for a total of 19 projects through the NSW Government's 2018 Community Building Partnership Program.

Member for Murray Austin Evans said the State Government funds will deliver much-needed improvements to local facilities including upgrades to playgrounds, ovals, kiosks and also the purchase of two vehicles.

"The NSW Government's strong economic management ensures we are in a position to invest in these important local projects.

"This is fantastic news for Murray that this grassroots funding will directly help to create a more vibrant and inclusive local community with fantastic outcomes," Mr Evans said.

Balranald Men's Shed Inc will receive \$8,000 to upgrade the flooring in the tea room.

"I congratulate the Men's Shed and look forward to visiting the shed when the project is completed".

The Community Building Partnership program has funded some 13,800 community projects since it commenced nearly a decade ago.
