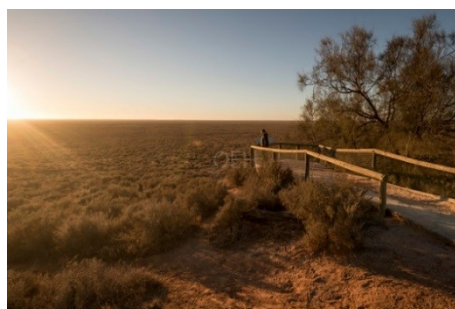
MUNGO NATIONAL PARK

Mungo National Park is situated within the Willandra Lakes World Heritage Area; it is an area of international significance for its cultural, archaeological, and natural landscape features. It is a place of striking beauty and cultural richness and tells the dramatic story of landscape and climate change. Mungo National Park is jointly managed between the traditional Aboriginal groups of this area and the NSW National Parks and Wildlife Service. Representatives of the Barkindji/Paakantji, Ngyiampaa and Mutthi Mutthi tribal groups are employed as NPWS Aboriginal Discovery guides. Our guides have a wealth of traditional knowledge to share about this unique and special place with you.

WALK THE WALLS OF CHINA TOUR

Walk with an experienced NPWS Aboriginal Discovery guide back in time on the famous Walls of China to learn about the 40,000+ years of Aboriginal cultural history of Lake Mungo, the traditional people and the Willandra Lakes as you explore sites of cultural significance. You will be Welcomed to Country and engaged in a cultural experience unique to the Mungo Landscape and the traditional NPWS Aboriginal Discovery guides.

Note: You will follow the NPWS service vehicle to the Walls of China carpark in your own vehicle. Access to the Walls of China is by guided tour only.

\$8.00 per day for standard vehicles.

\$10 per mini bus (up to 8 seats)

\$15 per mini-coach per day (less than 22 seats) \$30 per coach per day (22-44) \$40 per coach per day (greater than 44 seats).

Camping Fees: apply within Mungo National Park.
